Hello,

My name is Robin and I would like to give you some informations about me, hoping to get your curiosity.

My parents say I'm a sandwich child – above me my older sister Sarah (21 years old; she studies medicine in Berne) and my brother Michael (18 Years old; he still goes to high school), below me my brother Marc (13 years old; he is in secondary school). We live in the very heart of Switzerland, in Schwyz. Here we are surrounded by a beautiful countryside, with many mountains waiting to be ascended by my family.

My family is made up of my brothers and sister, my parents, as well as our two cats. Both my parents are self-employed: my mother as a pediatrician and my father as a lawyer. My mum tries to do her best to be home early enough to cook lunch for us each day, but she doesn't always succeed. That is why I often start to cook for our family. We also have some duties at home, like cleaning, dish washing and gardening.

I have a very good relationship with my siblings. We spend a lot of our free time together and I would do anything for all of them because I really love my family. But naturally we do have also our spats from time to time. With my parents – and more and more with my sister – I can talk about everything. I can talk with them about every important decision in my life, like school or study abroad or about disputes with my brothers. Sometimes I need to hear their opinion on something, because it helps me to decide. I'm so happy to have this kind of relationship with my family and we can share all our feelings and everyday worries. At home I really like to repair something or do some gardening together with my mum.

If my family had to describe me, my mother would say : I'm always helpful, very empathic and a very sensitive person. "A great pal" would be my friends opinion. I think, I have a lot of friends; but I especially spend a lot of time with two boys from my class. It's important to me, that I can count on real friends on which I can trust. Sometimes we go to the cinema or cycling or we just hangout.

As for my hobbies: I like to go hiking with my family and from time to time it's just a men only team, with my brother, my father and grandfather joining in.

Especially in summer I do athletics in a team – we have trainings every week and we also have some competitions on the weekends. Last summer we were really successful – we got the third position in a Swiss competition.

In summer I love to go to the nearby lake after school and swim there with my friends.

In winter I really love skiing – carving through powder is my great passion!

Since two seasons I have discovered a new free time activity: I spend a lot of free weekends working as a waiter at a restaurant in the local ski-area. So I earn my own money and I enjoy working with people and the waiting on tables outside.

Currently I go to high school; there I am in ninth grade in a bilingual class: we have several subjects in English instead of German. I am lucky that my school is located just around the corner; it only takes me a few minutes to go to school by feet; but sometimes I envy the other students who have to take a bus or train to get to the school because they can spend this way more time together.

My favorite profession is to become an architect; in school I really like mathematics, history, English, geography and of course sports.

My mother and grandmother often talk about the time when my mum went to high school and they hosted for several months students from other countries. To this day they have kept in touch with one of those students. Some time ago he and his family came to Switzerland and they stayed with us for a couple of weeks. We really enjoyed this time together. We had interesting discussions and got to know another culture.

Furthermore my elder brother Michael was with AFS about one year ago for one year in Australia. He really enjoyed his year to the full – and he came back as another person – so perfectly satisfied, so thoroughly happy! He told us so much about his experiences as a student in a foreign country, about life in another country; in a new family – so it was clear for me, that I also would like to do the same!

At the same year as Michael was in Australia, we hosted also for one year a student from Slovakia. That was a great experience too! So we had the opportunity to learn something about her culture – about her way of living.

It is my great wish to initiate my own experience through my own exchange year, to meet new people, see new places and immerse myself in the daily life of a country that is totally new to me.
